Subject: Spring semester exam period, 2021-22

The final exam period for the spring semester is approaching (beginning June 26). Most exams will be held in-person on campus ("pen and paper"), but some will be held using the Tomax platform, in accordance with information you received from your instructors and departments.

The list of courses for Tomax-based exams (with or without Zoom) can be found [here](#). There may still be modifications to this list until June 15, 2022. Exams for courses not listed will be held on campus as usual. It is your responsibility to remain up-to-date on the status of your own exams.

Tomax + Zoom

Some online courses will also require a Zoom session on your cellphone. The Zoom room appears on the [In-Bar](#) portal under the exam schedule. Additionally, **two days** prior to the exam, the room number will be sent to you via email. The table of Zoom room links appears on the [In-Bar](#) home page. Examinees who are required to enter a Zoom room and do not do so will have their exams disqualified.

Registration for Tomax-based exams on campus

Students taking Tomax-based exams online who prefer to do so on campus computers under human supervision must register by selecting the registration button in [In-Bar](#). **Contrary to previous semesters, this registration is required now for each exam you wish to take on campus computers.** Registration for all exams in one shot is no longer possible.

For Moed Aleph – Registration begins 30 days before the exam date and closes 14 days before the exam date (other than exams held in the first week, for which you may register until Thursday, June 16, 2022).

For Moed Bet – Registration begins 14 days before the exam date and closes 7 days before the exam date.

The **cancel registration** button will appear in [In-Bar](#) as long as registration is open, in accordance with the schedule shown above.

Instructions for software download, simulation exam and version upgrade

[Click here for link](#) – the simulation exam is open for a trial run at any time. Students who have never taken a Tomax-based exam must run at least one simulation exam before the actual exam!

Please note: A version upgrade will take place on June 14, 2022. The upgrade process is short and is activated automatically when you open Vix. Open the application and confirm the upgrade. At the end of the upgrade, **we recommend you take the simulation exam to verify that the upgraded software is functioning properly on your computer.** We recommend that you upgrade the software version as early as possible, rather than delay it to the day of the exam.
