Subject: University Protocol Following Operation "Am K'Lavi"

As you may be aware, the IDF has launched Operation "Am K'Lavi" aimed at dismantling Iran's nuclear program, during which multiple targets in Iran were attacked. In light of this, and in anticipation of potential retaliatory strikes by Iran in the coming days, the University administration has made the following decisions, in accordance with Home Front Command directives:

A. Classes:

Starting this Sunday, all academic instruction will shift to Zoom and will not be held on campus until further notice. Lectures will be recorded and uploaded to course websites, so that students unable to join live sessions can review the material at a later time. Please follow updates from your departments, particularly regarding off-campus activities such as clinics or practicums.

B. Exams:

Examinations originally scheduled to take place on campus this Sunday and Monday will be postponed. Exams scheduled to be held via the ToMEX platform will proceed as planned. Special accommodations will be made in exceptional cases. Further information about exams scheduled from Tuesday onward will be provided as the situation develops.

C. Academic Conferences:

Academic events and conferences planned for Sunday and Monday will either be postponed or moved to Zoom.

D. Campus Facilities:

On Sunday, all libraries will remain closed, and research activities on campus will be suspended, except in rare cases approved by the Vice President for Research. Updates will be provided by research group leaders as needed.

E. Cybersecurity:

Due to concerns over potential cyberattacks, the IT Department has implemented enhanced security measures. These are not expected to affect email or the learning platforms, but other limitations may occur. Please remain vigilant for phishing attempts and avoid opening emails from unfamiliar senders.

F. Ongoing Monitoring:

We are closely monitoring developments and will adjust our policies as needed based on evolving circumstances and further guidance from the Home Front Command. Please stay attentive to official university communications.

G. Support for Reservists:

We extend our support and prayers to our students and faculty members called up for reserve duty. We are committed to assisting and supporting them upon their return.
