Below are several important announcements as we begin the academic year today, Sunday, December 31, 2023.

Campus entry and presence on campus

Identification upon campus entry – Everyone entering the campus gates must present an official photo ID (Israel ID, passport, driver's license, student ID card with photo, or digital student ID card via the Bar-Ilan cellphone app).

Schedules

On the <u>In-Bar</u> portal you can view your schedule, where two types of courses appear: classroom-based courses are indicated with a building and room number, while courses held by Zoom only indicated "Zoom-based" in place of a room number.

"My Bar-Ilan" student portal

<u>The "My Bar-Ilan" student portal</u> summarizes for you all Bar-Ilan digital platforms at a single location and includes a full list for available actions and filling out forms. Log in to the portal using your <u>365 user ID</u>. Further details are available in this video.

Schedule change window

The <u>In-Bar online registration</u> platform will be open for registration and for adding or dropping courses, from December 24, 2023 through January 11, 2024. After this window no further course scheduling changes may be made. A message with details has been sent via email and posted on <u>In-Bar</u>.

Info stations and campus map

During the first week of the academic year, info stations will be set up in various central campus locations, from Sun-Thurs, between 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM. These will be located at: the Geha gate (30), the Dekalim gate (5), the main gate (2) and in the central walkway (opposite Building 507).

Open Door service via Zoom

Service of the <u>Open Door</u> channel may be obtained via **Zoom** for questions on administrative issues and possible studies at Bar-Ilan. The service is available on Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays between 10 AM and 12 Noon.

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Cellular app

The <u>Bar-Ilan University app</u> (Mobitti) is available to you, adapted for cellular (the official version). The app is available both on Android and IOS (iPhone). Using the app, you may remain up to date on schedules, grades, exam hours, exam locations, navigation on campus and campus map, Bar-Ilan library information, Facebook access and the academic calendar.

Student ID cards and proof of student status

Students who have registered for their courses can find their student ID on the Bar-Ilan app and generate a proof of student status through In-Bar (authorizations/forms).

Office Hours at the Services and Recruitment Center

On the first week of classes, between 9 AM and 3 PM, administrative unit representatives will be waiting for you at the <u>Services and Recruitment Center</u> (Area 502 Building 19, near Building 605) to answer questions.

The units providing service at the center are tuition, curriculum planning, status, admissions, graduate school, scholarships and library and information services.

English content courses

Keep in mind – students who began their undergraduate studies in 2021-22 or in 2022-23 and are exempt from English as a Foreign Language, are still required for taking English content courses. <u>Details here</u>.

Scholarships

You may apply for scholarships through <u>In-Bar</u> per the criteria indicated on the <u>Academic Secretariat – Scholarship Unit</u>.
