**Campus entry and presence on campus**

**Identification upon campus entry** – Every person entering the campus gates must present an official photo ID (Israel ID, passport, driver's license, student ID card with photo, or digital student ID card via the Bar-Ilan cellphone app). Registered students may also access the campus through smart turnstiles that employ BLE technology using their mobile phone. Entry is permitted only to the authorized individual.

**Schedules**

On the [In-Bar](#) portal you can view your schedule, where two types of courses appear: classroom-based courses are indicated with a building and room number, while courses held by Zoom only indicated "Zoom-based" in place of a room number.

**The Lomda platform**

Lomda is Bar-Ilan's digital learning platform. It allows access to course content, connectivity to Zoom lectures, viewing course recordings and contact with instructors. Lomda is also used to submit assignments and take exams.

### **Schedule change window**

The [In-Bar online registration](#) platform will be open for registration and for adding or dropping courses, from November 4-5, 2024 through November 18, 2024. After this window no further course scheduling changes may be made. Details will be announced on In-Bar.

### **Info stations and campus map**

During the first week of the academic year, info stations will be set up in various central campus locations, from Sun-Thurs, between 7:30 AM and 3:30 PM. These will be located at the Geha gate (30), the Dekalim gate (5), the main gate (2) and in the central walkway (opposite Building 507).

### **Open Door service via Zoom**

Service of the [Open Door](#) channel may be obtained via **Zoom** for questions on administrative issues and possible studies at Bar-Ilan. The service is available on Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays between 10 AM and 12 Noon.

### **Cellular app**

The [Bar-Ilan University app](#) (Mobitti) is available to you, adapted for cellular (the official version). The app is available both on Android and IOS (iPhone). Using the app, you may remain up to date on schedules, grades, exam hours, exam locations, navigation on campus and campus map, Bar-Ilan library information, Facebook access and the academic calendar.

### **Student ID cards and proof of student status**

Students who have registered for their courses can find their student ID on the Bar-Ilan app and generate a proof of student status through [In-Bar](#) (authorizations/forms).

### **Office Hours at the Services and Recruitment Center**

On the first week of classes, between 9 AM and 3 PM, administrative unit representatives will be waiting for you at the [Services and Recruitment Center](#) (Area 502 Building 19, near Building 605) to answer questions.
